STUDENT ARRIVAL TIME: Students should plan to arrive at Elley-Long Music Center at least 45 minutes prior to their assigned rehearsal slot. Each student is requested to **sit on stage** with the students who are rehearsing. This “on-deck” experience will prepare them to conduct their own rehearsal. We expect students to take part in the Workshops which have been especially designed for student composers. Parents are welcome to join the rehearsals and workshops if interested.
