Remember, you want to *paint with the music, and use sounds* as your colors and device to create the music you want.
 - What will it sound like? How will you make it sound like that?
 - What is the range of the instruments high or low? How does this affect the sound?
 - What dynamic will the instruments play?
 - Do the instruments play different roles?
 - What is the pace and speed of the music? What is the pace of individual instruments?
 - What is the form of the piece like? Try to map it out if you can.
 - Can you describe the music in words?
